Most Needed Household Items:

Irons, ironing boards, laundry baskets
Rugs, cushions, pillows
Lamps, Coffee tables, end tables *
Sofas, art for walls, mirrors
Blenders, microwaves, Instapots, crockpots
Rice pots, rice cookers, pots, pans, can openers
Electric tea kettles, tea cups, pot holders
Dinnerware, kitchen utensils, cutting boards
Dining tables and chairs, kitchen linens
Clothing dressers, desks
Duvets, bedspreads, sheet sets
Vacuums, brooms, dustpans, mops, buckets
Baby and child toys and art supplies
Baby swings, high chairs, changing tables
Children and adult (modest) clothing
Computers, scissors, umbrellas, wallets
Televisions, new roku, tv antennas
Bicycles, Bike locks (U-locks)
Bath mats, towels, shower curtains
Shoes, all ages and genders
Sewing machines, fabric, thread

Most Needed Pantry and Personal Items:

Shampoo, conditioner, soap bars, sponges
Hair brushes, combs, lotion, shaving cream, deodorant
Dish soap, laundry detergent, bathroom cleaners
Sanitary pads, children's diapers (all sizes)
Light bulbs, household cleaning supplies
Nonperishable foods including rice, dry beans, dry milk
First Aid Kits
